



In accordance with NASRA bylaws, each state is allowed only one vote on matters, and the vote must be cast by the person designated on the annual NASRA Membership form. If, for any reason, your state finds it necessary to change the designated voting member, *the new designated voting member must complete, sign, and submit a Designated Voting Member form.*

There may be occasions when it is necessary for NASRA to conduct business other than at the annual business meeting. Minnesota Statute § 317A.447 allows members to take action without a meeting, by ballot, if NASRA delivers a ballot to every member entitled to vote on the matter. NASRA may deliver the ballot to a member by electronic communication, if the member has provided NASRA with consent to receive notices by electronic communication (MN Stat. § 317A.450).
